This summer, we held two Vacation Bible days. Since our students were involved in other programs, we met on August 9th and August 23rd. The focus this summer was on "Exploring the Sacraments." Our pre-teen students have experienced many church topics in the past summers, so looking at who we are as Episcopalians will help prepare them for Confirmation.

Session one started with the "Rite of Baptism" followed by the study of "The Holy Eucharist" (or Holy Communion). While touring the church and participating in a fun scavenger hunt, the young people learned the different parts of a church building. Back in the parish hall, we discussed "the onward and visible signs" of both Sacraments. We also went over what was "the Inward and Spiritual Grace" of each one. Prayer, snacks, and crafts rounded out our time together.

Our next session focused on "The Liturgy of the Word" and the seasons of the church year. We looked at our Sunday leaflet, as well as The Book of Common Prayer. We matched each church season with the color assigned to it. John Kracker introduced the students to the hymnal and how to locate service music and music for each church season. We had a great time exploring from the front of the hymnal to the back. The study of the Sacraments will continue in September at our "Sunday on Saturday" class time.

I want to thank John Kracker for helping with the class lessons and games this summer. Also, thanks go to Mark Sullivan and Janice Fetscher for their continued support.

As we move into the fall season, look out for "Something New for our Children Under Five." After the older children have their "Sunday on Saturday" lessons from 10 to noon, a class time is being designed just for our younger children. It will include a Bible story, hands-on fun with the "Godly Play" materials, and an art project. This class will meet from 12 noon to 12:30 pm. Snacks will be included as well. We hope the parents will see this as a new way to introduce Bible lessons to their children. The next session will be held on Saturday, September 30th. Remember to keep all of our children in your prayers as they return to a new school year.
